

Congressman Allen West, disturbed by the Supreme Court's ruling upholding most of the new health care law, said American voters will make the ultimate decision at the polls this November.

West, a Republican from Plantation and tea party favorite, said the court's decision on the law threatens "individual sovereignty" by forcing people to buy insurance.

"The American people have to be very concerned about the growth and the power of the American government as per this decision today," West said in an interview on Thursday. "The people will start to wake up and see that this is a very onerous overreach by the federal government."

West's reaction indicates that some Republicans will use the ongoing debate over the new law to try to gain seats in Congress and oust President Obama..

"The ultimate response will come from the American people," he said.

What form will that reaction take?

"You have to wait until the 6th of November," he said, referring to Election Day.
